NEBOSH Unitised Diploma Unit C

What's the business benefit?

All organisations require by law professional advice on health and safety requirements. This is a course for those intending to become professional safety and health practitioners.

The new unitised NEBOSH Dip has allowed us to use ECIF funding to remit some of the fees for units B and Unit C.

The programme starting in April is for Unit 'C' – 'Workplace and Work Equipment'. Candidates can start unit 'A' from Sept 2010.

When is it and what's it costs?

- You pay £350 + VAT (ECIF pays £250)
- Registration Fee £50.00
- Examination Entry Fee £75.00 per unit



IEMA Associate Certificate

What's the business benefit?
